



Distinctively Swathed in the Legacy of Three Generations

Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (UPSI) is a renowned public Institution of Higher Education in the history of national education. This institution gradually developed from a college to a university across four eras starting with Sultan Idris Training College (SITC) which was established on the 29th November, 1922. In 1957, SITC was rebranded into Maktab Perguruan Sultan Idris (MPSI) and it was then named Institut Perguruan Sultan Idris (IPSI) in 1987. IPSI was upgraded to a university in 1997 known as Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (UPSI). On the 1st May 1997, UPSI was incorporated under the Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (Corporation) Order 1997 and the Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris Order (Campus) 1997 through the Government Gazette P.U. (A) 132 & 133 dated 24th February, 1997.

The role of Richard Olaf Winstedt (R.O. Winstedt) was recorded in the history of SITC as the earliest prominent English figure who

proposed the establishment of a college to train teachers and expand the scope of Education to the Conference of Residents on May 10, 1917. To realize the establishment of a college, the criterion for SITC location was pertinent. The location should be fertile to accommodate the needs of the curriculum that was agriculture-based; near public transport facilities, especially railway, road and river networks; and had a moderately large population composition. Thus, the district of Tanjong Malim was chosen due to its suitability and accessibility.

On the 26th of May 1917, Tanjong Malim was officially chosen as the site for the construction of the college and was named Sultan Idris Training College (SITC) in memory of the services of the late Sultan of Perak, His Royal Highness Sultan Idris Mursyidul Adzam Shah who ruled the state of Perak between 1889-1916. The construction of the SITC campus on a 64-hectare land with a Medieval Gothic architectural design began in August, 1919 and it was fully completed on 29th of November, 1922. This campus was subsequently

officialiated by Sir W. George Maxwell, Chief Secretary of the Government of the Federated Malay States.

The establishment of SITC was seen as the beginning of a new age that would further advance the Malay nation's intellectual and educational development. In his speech at the SITC officiating ceremony, Mr. Wolffe, the Director of Education for the Straits Settlements, stated that the event marked a pivotal moment in the development of Malay vernacular education and was an unparalleled recognition and appreciation for raising the educational standards of Malay children, not just for Malays in Malaya but also for those from Brunei, Borneo, and Singapore.

SITC produced its first 58 trained teachers in March 1924. The intake and the number of trained teachers produced has been increasing continously on yearly basis. The inception of SITC marked the beginning of an era in which the Karang Mengarang Office played a crucial role in establishing the nation's civilisation through the Malay language, particularly under the direction of Zainal Abidin Ahmad, or better known as Za'ba.

In 1957, the name of SITC was changed to Maktab Perguruan Sultan Idris (MPSI) in accordance with the recommendations of the Razak Report. This change brought about the transformation of identity of this teacher education center from a centre that was overshadowed by Europeans to

one that fostered the Malay character and personality.

MPSI became a hub for the expression of speech and the voice of intellectuals and nationalists. Throughout the SITC era the Malay language was used as a corpus and the world of creative writings among teacher trainees and teaching staff germinated. It was in this era that several prominent figures in the literary world were born such as A. Wahab Ali, Ali Majod, Kasmani Hj. Arif, Awang Had Salleh, Hassan Ali, Othman Puteh, Rahman Shaari, Dharmawijaya, Kemala, Suhaimi Hj. Mohammad, Shahnnon Ahmad, Suratman Markasan, Masuri S.N. and Yura Halim.

The era of MPSI ended on 21st of February, 1987 when its status as a college was further upgraded to an institute with the name of Sultan Idris Teacher Training Institute (IPSI). In line with the current challenging needs, IPSI strode forward by introducing the Special Teacher Certificate Course (KSPK) in 1987, the Post Graduate Teacher Course (KPLI) in 1988 and twinning programs with local universities in 1993.


IPSI entered its new era in 1997 when the institution was officially upgraded into a university to carry out government orders through the P.U Government Gazette. (A) 132 and 133 dated 24 February 1997. So on the 1st of May 1997, Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris, which is known today by its abbreviation

UPSI, was established. UPSI began operating as a university on 2nd of May, 1997 with 350 students. Datuk Dr. Ashari Che Mat was appointed as the first Vice Chancellor, while Professor Dato' Dr. Abu Bakar Nordin as the Academic Deputy Vice-Chancellor and assisted by Encik Sayuti Sahlan as the Registrar, Encik Yusof Semahil (Treasurer), in addition to six administrative staff and 29 academic staff who were mostly seconded from various agencies of the Ministry of Education Malaysia.

UPSI began its operation with four faculties - the Faculty of Languages, the Faculty of Science and Technology, the Faculty of Social Sciences and Arts and the Faculty of Cognitive Science and Human Development. UPSI continues to grow and currently has nine faculties namely the Faculty of Languages and Communication, the Faculty of Music and Performing Arts, the Faculty of Human Development, the Faculty of Science and Mathematics, the Faculty of Arts, Computing and Creative Industries, the Faculty of Management and Economics, the Faculty of Sports Science and Coaching, Faculty of Humanities, the Faculty of Technical and Vocational and an Institute of Graduate Studies.

Infrastructure in UPSI began with the construction of the Chancellery Building in 2000





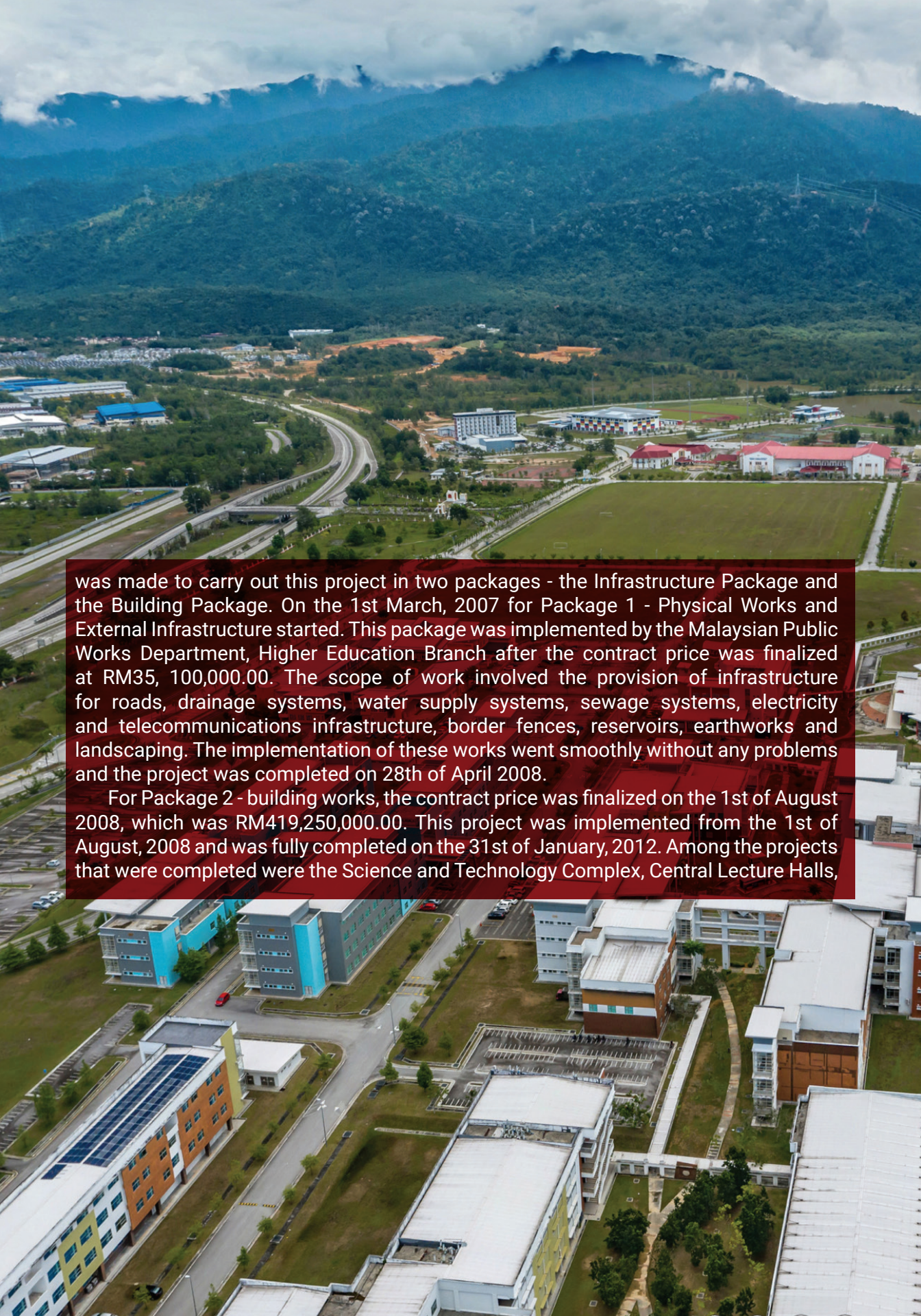
and the Student Residence Complex in Behrang Ulu consisting of Za'ba College and Aminuddin Baki College. Then, at the beginning of 2001, the construction of the Gymnasium complex, Library, Auditorium, and lecture halls began. Some of the existing facilities from SITC-MPSI-IPSI's legacy were renovated with some updates, in line with technological advances, while maintaining their original structure and facade. In 2010, the E-Learning building was completed which completes UPSI's facilities as this building provides large-sized lecture rooms, tutorial rooms, computer labs,

office spaces, convention centers and distance education facilities.

Realizing that the Sultan Abdul Jalil Shah Campus was insufficient to meet the needs of students, the Eighth Malaysia Plan initiated the construction of the Sultan Azlan Shah Campus to complement the Sultan Abdul Jalil Shah Campus (RMK-8). At the initial stage, the proposed site was Kuala Kangsar, Perak. However, the government later decided that the new UPSI campus would be built in Proton City, Behrang Ulu with an area of 800 acres.

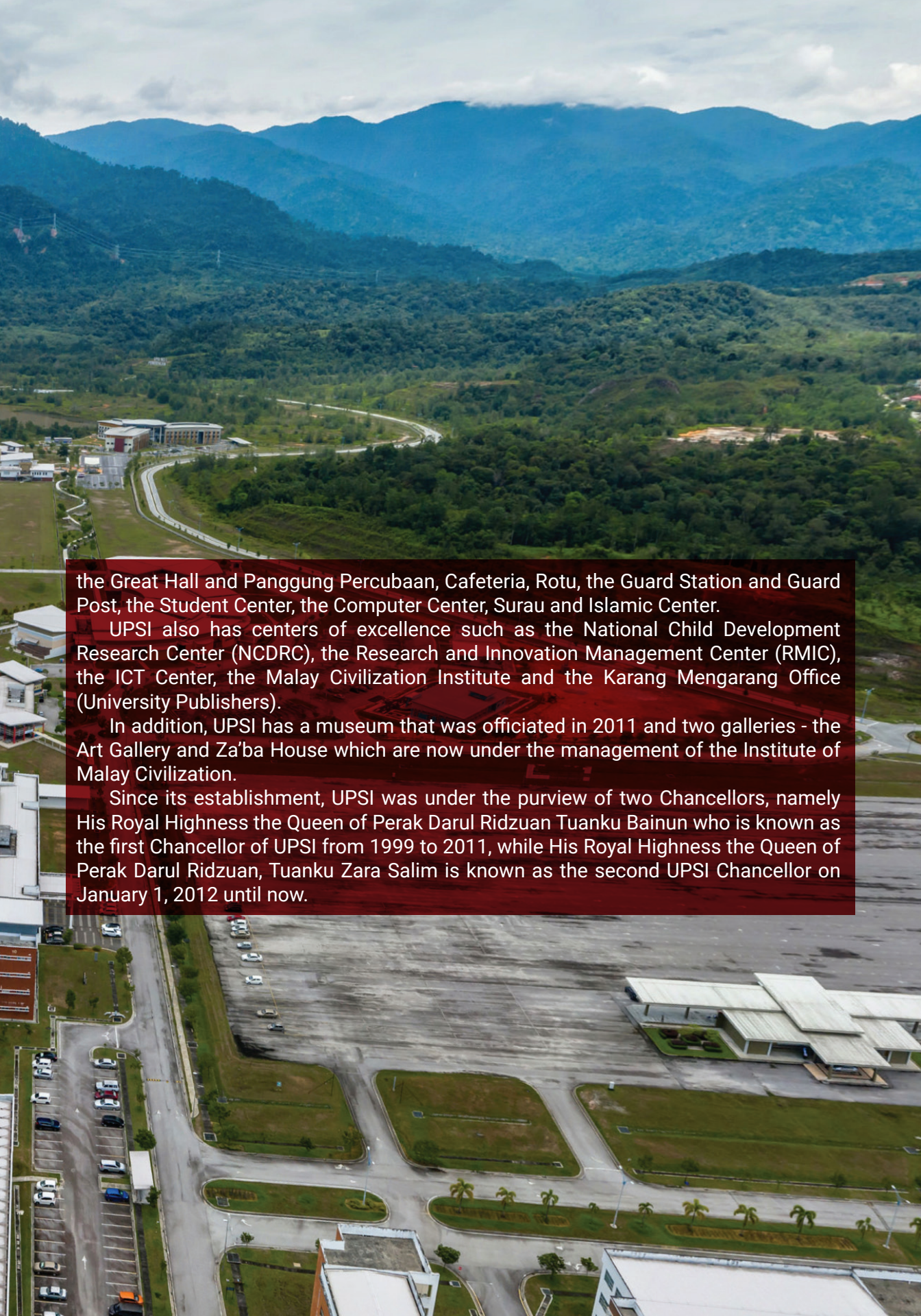
The selection of the Sultan Azlan Shah Campus site in Bandar Baru, Proton City was suitable to bring about developmental impact to the surrounding areas, especially to the Proton City itself. In addition to its close proximity to the Proton City Commercial Center and the Proton factory, this area also has the backdrop of the lush greenery of the Titiwangsa Mountain range. The beauty of this natural resource becomes an added value in the learning process of UPSI students. The clear water in the creeks from the Titiwangsa Mountain Range that flows into the lake in the middle of the campus can be an attraction for sports, leisure and tourism activities.

In the Ninth Malaysia Plan (RMK-9), the Ministry of Higher Education and the Economic Planning Unit had approved an allocation ceiling of RM460,469,000.00 to implement this campus construction project. On June 26, 2006, the government appointed the Malaysian Public Works Department, Education Branch as the Project Manager on behalf of UPSI. In the second meeting on 19th of July 2006, the decision



was made to carry out this project in two packages - the Infrastructure Package and the Building Package. On the 1st March, 2007 for Package 1 - Physical Works and External Infrastructure started. This package was implemented by the Malaysian Public Works Department, Higher Education Branch after the contract price was finalized at RM35, 100,000.00. The scope of work involved the provision of infrastructure for roads, drainage systems, water supply systems, sewage systems, electricity and telecommunications infrastructure, border fences, reservoirs, earthworks and landscaping. The implementation of these works went smoothly without any problems and the project was completed on 28th of April 2008.

For Package 2 - building works, the contract price was finalized on the 1st of August 2008, which was RM419,250,000.00. This project was implemented from the 1st of August, 2008 and was fully completed on the 31st of January, 2012. Among the projects that were completed were the Science and Technology Complex, Central Lecture Halls,



the Great Hall and Panggung Percubaan, Cafeteria, Rotu, the Guard Station and Guard Post, the Student Center, the Computer Center, Surau and Islamic Center.

UPSI also has centers of excellence such as the National Child Development Research Center (NCDRC), the Research and Innovation Management Center (RMIC), the ICT Center, the Malay Civilization Institute and the Karang Mengarang Office (University Publishers).

In addition, UPSI has a museum that was officiated in 2011 and two galleries - the Art Gallery and Za'ba House which are now under the management of the Institute of Malay Civilization.

Since its establishment, UPSI was under the purview of two Chancellors, namely His Royal Highness the Queen of Perak Darul Ridzuan Tuanku Bainun who is known as the first Chancellor of UPSI from 1999 to 2011, while His Royal Highness the Queen of Perak Darul Ridzuan, Tuanku Zara Salim is known as the second UPSI Chancellor on January 1, 2012 until now.
